Course Description:

Reading Skills is a method of academic intervention to provide early, systematic assistance to students who are having difficulty in a specific content area. Reading Skills class will focus on early reading interventions with the research based Scholastic READ 180 program. READ 180 is an intensive reading intervention program designed to meet the needs of students whose reading achievement is below the proficient level.

Course Goals:

Students in Reading Skills class will receive research based whole group, small group and individualized instructional support in the core topics of reading comprehension, fluency, vocabulary, grammar, spelling, and word recognition. The desired outcome is that students will raise their literacy proficiency across all subjects and develop a genuine pleasure in reading and writing.

Student Materials Needed:

Grading:
